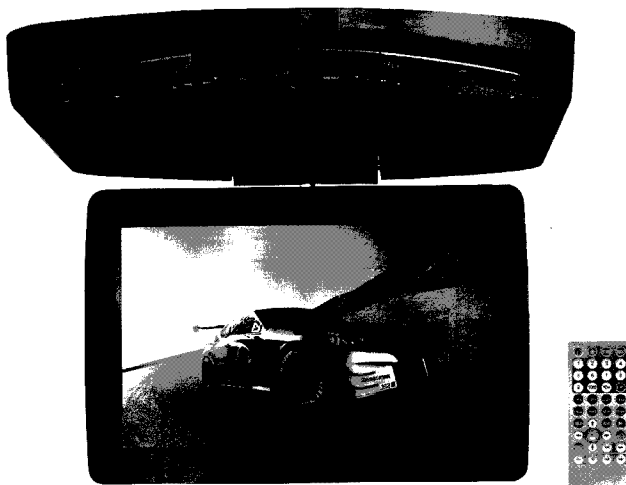

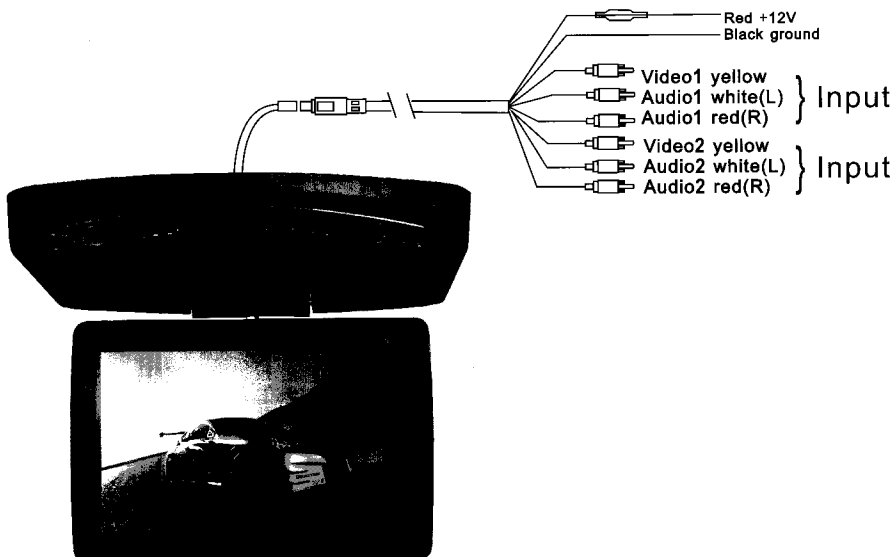

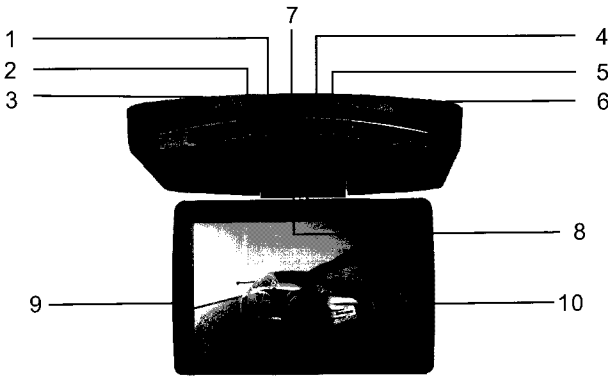
A. Specifications

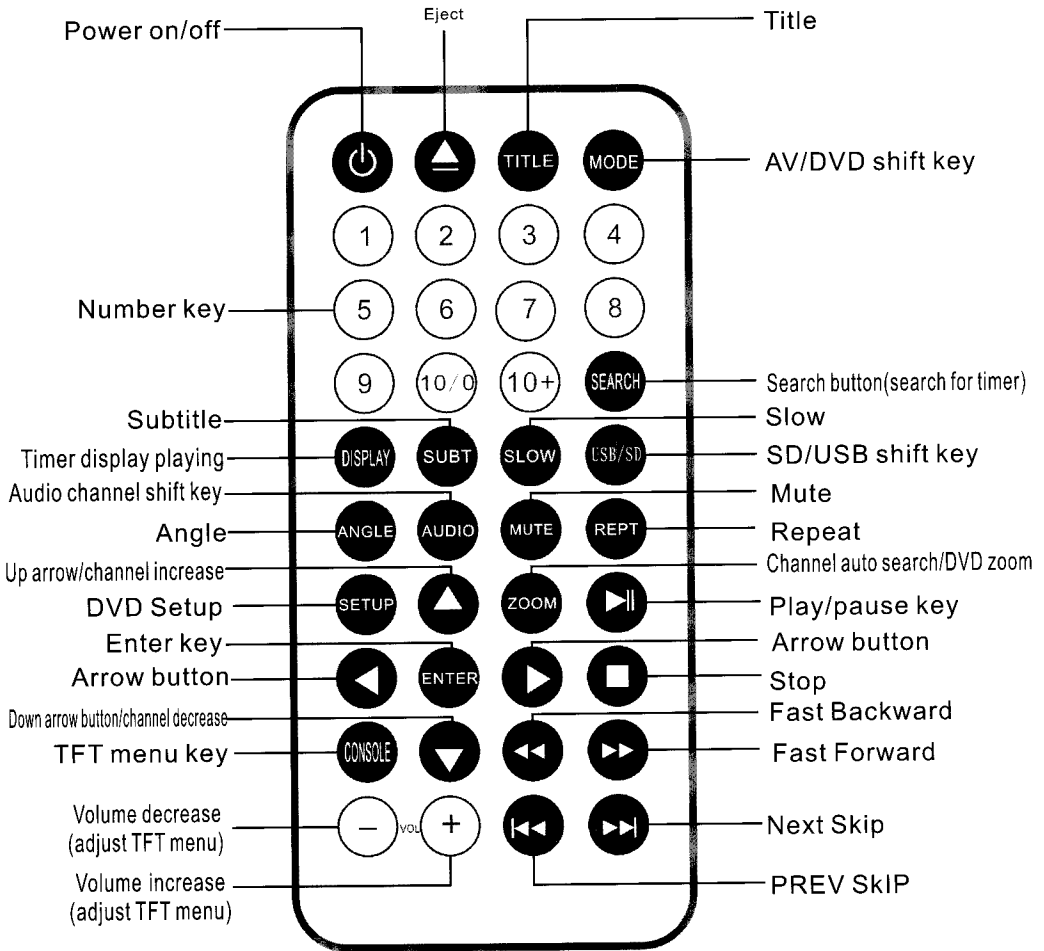


- 1.  Power (on/off)

D.Remote control panel function description



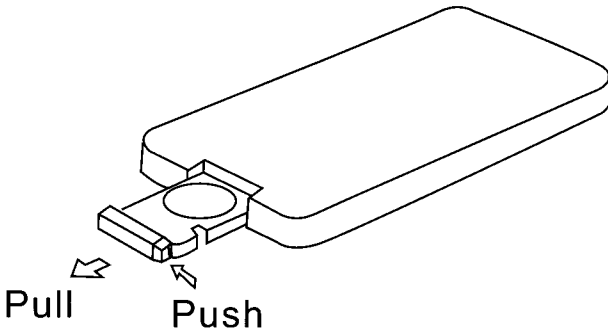
E.Remote control panel using

- 1.Reference to instruction for remote control(shown as pictures),pull out the battery tray and insert the battey(type CR2025)with the stamped(+) mark facing upward. Insert the battery tray into the remote control.
- 2.Direct the remote controller to infrared receiver window of the machine with in 60 degree and 5 metres without any barriers between them.

3. Commonly the life-span of the batteries is about one year, always replace the old set of new batteries.

4. Please take out the battery when not using the remote controller for a long time.

5. Please pull out the separation film before when using the remote controller



WARNING:

Store the battery where children cannot reach; Do not recharge, short, disassemble or heat the battery or dispose it in a fire.
