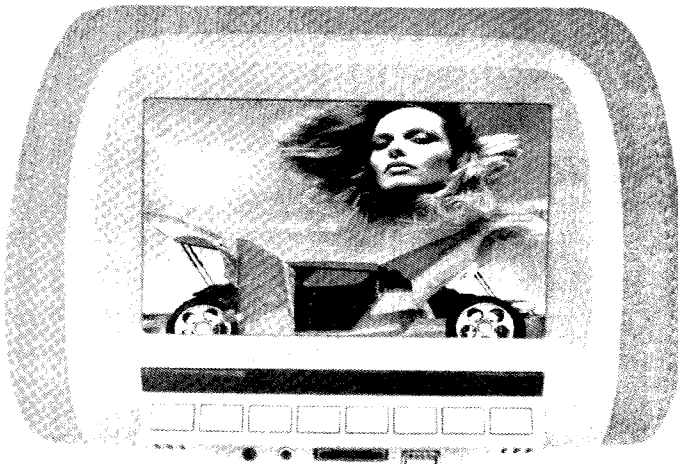

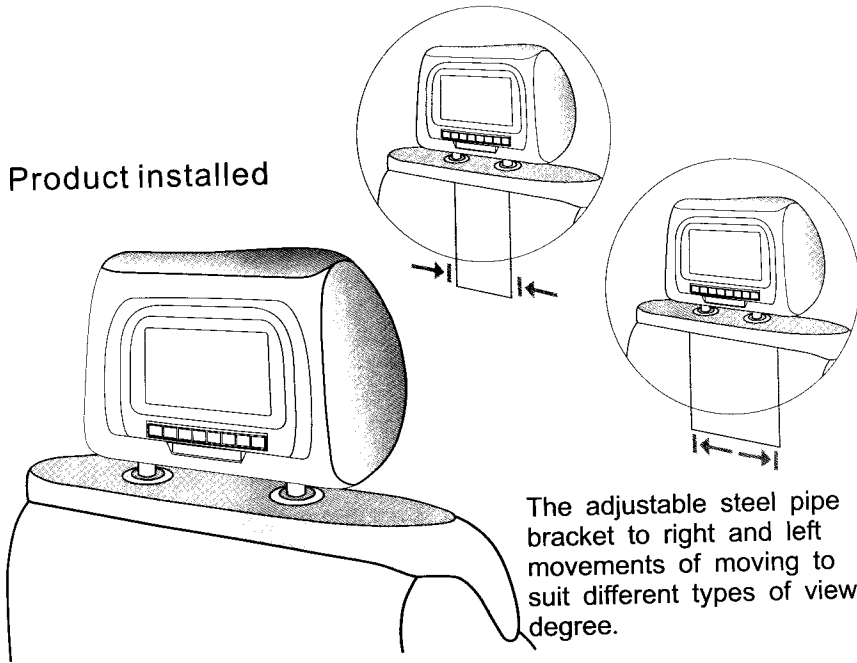

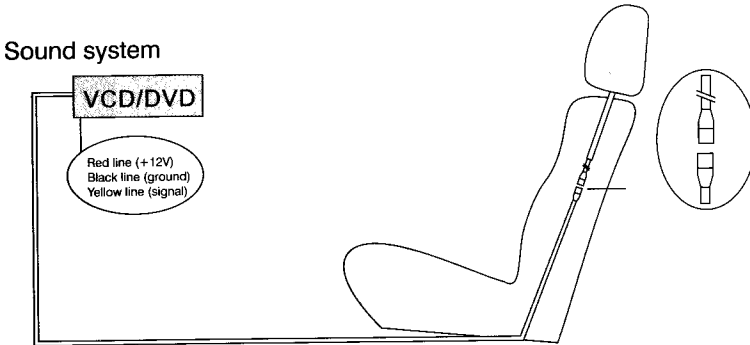

Congratulations on your purchase of this headrest monitor system. The product is designed and built to deliver excellent video quality and long lasting high performance. For best results please consult a professional mobile electronics installer for application advice or troubleshooting. Please read these instructions thoroughly before installation.

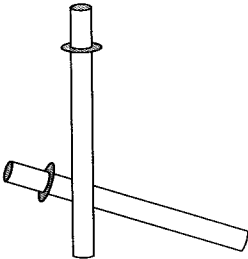
Installation Instructions

1. Remove the existing headrest from the seat.
2. Adjust the posts of the new headrest to fit the holes in the seat where the headrest will be installed. The post can be moved together or apart: grasp one post in each hand, move the posts in right and left movements while pushing them toward each other or away from each other.
3. Insert the cable in the proper hole. Insert the posts into the holes in the seat and carefully work the headrest into position. Make sure the cable is not pinched.
4. Run the cable down the seat and out to the location of the video source unit (such as a DVD player).
5. Connect the wires as indicated:
 - a. Red: Connect to a switched (+) 12 volt source (ACC). Use a lead that has (+) 12V when the ignition is on or in the ACC position so the monitors "hot" could cause your battery to run down when the engine is not running.
 - b. Black: Connect to a good chassis ground.
 - c. Reversing the polarity of the red and black leads will damage the monitor.
 - d. Connect the video input connector to the video output from the source unit (i.e.DVD player).
 - e. Test the system.

How to use the Adapter tubes

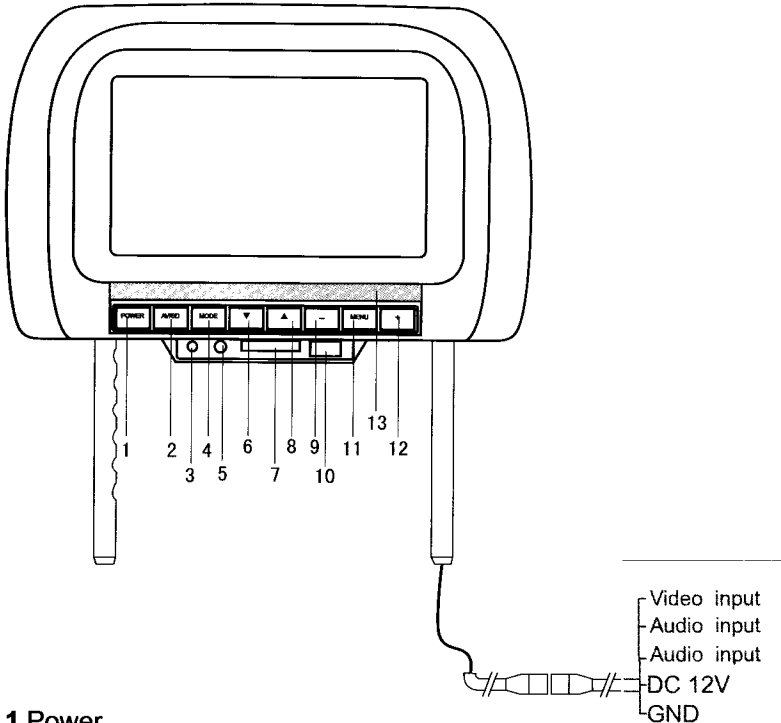


Since the spacing of the mounting holes can vary on different vehicles we supply two adapter tubes (12mm diameter). Use these tubes when the headrest mounting holes in your seat are too large for the posts of the headrest monitor.

Monitor Controls and Features

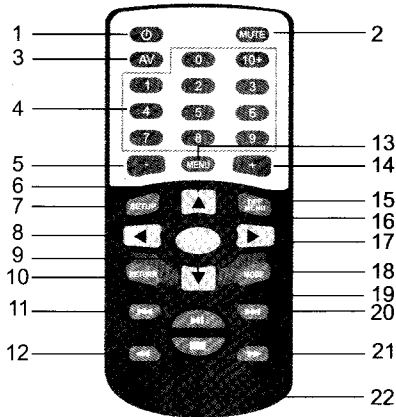
The monitor is designed to operate in ambient temperature from -20°C to +50°C. Do not bump or press on the screen as this may damage the unit, keep the unit away from moisture.

Troubleshooting

If you experience operation or performance problems with this product, compare you installation with the electrical wiring diagram on the previous page. If problems persist, read the following troubleshooting tips which may help eliminate the problems.

SYMPTOM	CAUSE	REMEDY
No picture or sound.	Power cord is not properly connected. Video input cables not properly connected. Video input source is not operating properly.	<i>Check that power connections are properly made and all fuses are in functioning condition.</i> <i>Check all cables.</i> <i>Replace or repair video source (DVD player, video game, etc.)</i>
No picture.	Video signal not present. Contrast and/or brightness is set improperly.	<i>Check all cables. If necessary, repair or replace video source.</i> <i>Adjust contrast and brightness levels to see if picture appears.</i>
